Saturday June 19th:

- Race 1: 9am, Pee Wee 6 & under, 1/2 hour race, \$25 entry, Approx. 1 mile course.
- Race 2: 9am, Pee Wee 7 & older, 1/2 hour race, \$25 entry, Race will be combined with 6 and under.
- Race 3: 10am, Mini's 1 hour race, \$35 entry Approx. 3-4 mile **watered** course for race 3, 4, & 5.
- Race 4: 12pm, Women's 1 hour race, \$35 entry **Must do half the laps as the leaders in race 3, 4, & 5.**
- Race 5: 2pm Vintage/Bomber race 1 hour race, \$25 entry, Up to 1974-Vintage, 1975-1984-Bomber

Sunday June 20th:

- Race 1: 8:30am, expert, 2 hour race, \$50 entry The **watered** course will be 4-5 miles in length for all races.
 - Race 2: 11:30am, novice, 2 hour race, \$50 entry
 - Race 3: 2:30pm, amateur, 2 hour race, \$50 entry
- Must do at least half of the laps as the leaders to finish.**

Riders Meeting: 15 minutes before each race on Saturday and Sunday

Sign Ups: Starting at 7am both days and closing at 2:00 pm.

Course Info: The elevation ranges from 4100 to 4600 feet. Course design will be similar to a WORCS course.

MRANN Rules apply: MRANN cards required. MRANN one day cards are available. Dead engine fueling in pits. No rider insurance. Participants and spectators assume all risk of injury and/or damages that may occur. **ABSOLUTELY NO PIT RIDING ON MOTORCYCLES OR QUADS!!!!**
